- reading leveled texts- A B C D E and F books!
- reading like AVID READERS! We just can't stop reading!
- writing persuasion pieces that convince others to help fix problems that we see in our school, our community, and the world
- counting and representing numbers 11-19

At Home Learning Tip:

Go to the Melrose Library and borrow some books to read at home together with your child. Have your child play teacher, or go on a snap word hunt, or act out the book afterwards!

- Read with your child every night for at least 15 minutes, and TALK about the books you read. Have your child retell what happened.
- At this point in the year, your child should be reading at a level C or D.
