

Dear Parents:

We are writing to inform you that, based on the most current guidance, all New York State mandates for updated physicals and immunizations remain intact for the upcoming school year. Our hope is that you will plan your child's appointments as soon as possible in order to meet these requirements.

All children entering grades K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11 must have an updated physical examination. This exam is best done by your child's own physician since he/she can then review and update their immunizations.

Please note that IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET BEFORE THE START OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, September 6, 2022.

Physical exam forms are due by October 15th. Only the NYS School Health Examination Form or an electronic health record equivalent can be accepted for physicals conducted on or after January 31, 2021. The NY State School Health Examination Form is here: <http://www.p12.nysed.gov/sss/d...>
