

### What you can do at home

- At-home learning will look different than a typical school day. The amount of time your child should be expected to engage in learning activities will vary by age and grade level.
- Make sure your child has a quiet place to work (ideally a desk or table) and the school supplies they need. Try to remove distractions like the television or other technology not needed for learning.
- Students will receive a schedule and flow of the day for their remote learning days. They will have a schedule for whole group live instruction, small group or perhaps one on one. Their independent tasks will be posted as well as pre-recorded video resources.
- Maintain communication with your child's teachers.

# Learning and Expectations from Home and



#### Remote Learning Expectations

- During hybrid or 100% remote learning, your child is expected to complete all assignments provided by the teacher. At the same time, we recognize that working independently at home is different and difficult for many students, so we want to provide flexibility.
- Students and families should check Google Class daily for important updates from their teachers.
- At-home assignments for the week or day will be posted in Google Class
- During remote learning, your teacher will conduct live classes via Google Meet or Zoom.
- Live class schedules will be posted on the SGL website
- When signing in for virtual classes or meetings, students are expected to be on time, and ready to learn. We suggest signing in 5 minutes before class starts.
- Reduce background noise and distractions as much as possible.
- Students are expected to be appropriately dressed for virtual classes and meetings

### Arriving to School

- Due to COVID 19 guidelines and Social Distancing students will not be permitted to enter the school before 8:30 am.
- 6th Grade- Students will line up outside and enter the side door located on Suffolk street, between Rivington and Stanton, closer to Stanton.
- 7th Grade- Students will line up outside the door located in the back of the school on Norfolk street, closer to Rivington Street.
- 8th Grade- Students will line up outside the door located in the back of the school on Suffolk street, closer to Rivington Street
- \*\*\*If a student arrives on school grounds when they should be remote learning from home, they will be sent back home. A courtesy phone call will be given to the parent/guardian, informing them that their child is being sent home because they are not to be on school grounds for that specific day.



### Entering the building

- Upon entering the school, the following will take place:
- Temperature checked (students with a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, will not be permitted to enter the building, parents/guardians of these students will receive a courtesy phone call informing them that their child has a temperature and will be sent home
- Students entering the school building will be provided a clearance wristband.
- Students will be required to wear a mask mask to enter the school building, based on federal and state guidelines masks must be worn by students at all times while in the building. Students are encouraged to bring their own mask, but masks will be provided to students, if necessary. The school will be given a limited supply so mask distribution cannot be guaranteed



### Breakfast and Lunch

- A cold breakfast and lunch will be supplied to all students. You
  may choose to send your child with their own lunch. However, we
  can not accommodate any request to store food in a refrigerator
  and heat up in a microwave.
- Due to COVID 19 regulations we are not permitted to accept and allow food deliveries for students.



### Instructional Support

- ALL students will have Asynchronous & Synchronous Instruction.
- ALL Students will have an opportunity for small group support from a teacher
- ALL Students will have time to work independently
- ALL students will have an opportunity for Social Emotional Support with small group Circle groups once a week.
- ALL students will be responsible to attending virtual classes and morning meetings. Students attendance will be documented during LIVE Virtual Classes when students are not physically in the building.
- All grade level programs for instruction for Virtual Learning will be posted on our school website, in our google classrooms and in our Virtual Main Office starting September 16, 2020



#### SEPTEMBER 16-20, 2020


- Teachers by grade level will host 1 hour community building, informational and tutorial sessions for students. Students will receive zoom links sent to their SGL email accounts.

- Only on September 21,2020 we will start arrival for 6<sup>th</sup> graders at 8:00 am to allow for parent drop off and questions.

#### Attendance Procedures

#### Visitor Protocol

- Due to COVID-19, visitors must be kept to a minimum.
- All visitors MUST <u>request an appointment with SGL</u> prior to coming to the building.

- All visitors MUST fill out the <u>DOE's health screening</u> prior to being admitted into any DOE building.
