SCEC Instructional Options for Students During COVID-19

The opening of schools is guided by information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Indiana State Department of Health, and the Local Board of Health. To accommodate students and families who cannot or choose not to return to school in person, the School City of East Chicago will offer the following options:

One of these options must be selected for a semester commitment during registration.

Plan A - Regular School Day Schedule (Attendance on campus 5 days a weeki

Plan B - Elearning lattendance Online during the Regular School Day 1



- Attendance five days a week
- Assignments are aligned to the Indiana Academic Standards for each grade level.
- Student grades will be calculated based on performance in all academic areas. Letter grades will be assigned.
- Students will participate in local and state assessments to determine educational needs.
- All teachers and staff will receive COVID-19 training.
- Everyone will be required to wear a mask when social distancing is NOT possible. Parents are responsible for masks.
- All staff and students must self-assess each morning
- All staff and students will receive a COVID care package at the beginning of the school year that includes a thermometer, two masks, and sanitizer.
- Different doors will be used for bus riders, walkers, and parents' pickup and drop offs
- Visitors will be restricted from building unless an emergency
- Assigned classroom and bus seats
- Frequent cleaning of high-traffic areas
- One way directional hallway signage
- All desks will face the same direction
- Frequent and mandatory hand washing

Note: Failure to commit by August 1st, student (s) will be nlaced in Plan A - traditional school setting.
