PORT CHESTER ELEMENTARY AFTER SCHOOL ASPIRES/ASPIRA PROGRAM

The Port Chester Council for the Arts, Inc. and One World United and Virtuous, Inc. are partners in the comprehensive elementary after school program in the Port Chester Elementary Schools: Edison School, John F. Kennedy School, King Street School and Park Avenue School. The program consists of a 45 minute "snupper" (snack/supper) meal provided through the Carver Center and homework assistance (groups alternate going to "snupper" and beginning their homework), and two (2) 45-minute enrichment sessions per day. Enrichment programs may include additional academic assistance (through teaching professionals and/or Khan Academy self-directed academic support programming); social-emotional support programming and character education through One World, virtual assemblies and programming through Family Services of Westchester; programs in the arts such as painting, collage, cartooning, filmmaking, dance, theater, storytelling and music; and physical activity such as Zumba, yoga and physical education. Programs will rotate daily so that children will be exposed to a maximum number of enrichment opportunities each week.

The program's main focus is to provide children with a positive, safe environment where they can explore many different types of creative and supportive opportunities for growth, and to support the learning environment that takes place in each school building during the day. In our post-COVID world, the ability to have the children feel safe in school and positive about their abilities is of critical importance. Special care is taken each and every day to allow for self-expression and confidence-building.

The following activities are scheduled at each building on a rotating basis. *These activities are subject to change (teacher absences/unavailability) and are not offered to every grade on every day. - 4. NO CHILD IS PERMITTED TO WALK HOME UNACCOMPANIED FROM THE PROGRAM; AN ADULT MUST BE PRESENT BEFORE ANY CHILD WILL BE RELEASED.
- 5. An ASPIRES/ASPIRA staff member will remain on site until every child is picked up each day.
