What We're Learning

Reading/Writing: Our students have been introduced to the letters N, W, P, H, M and A. We have learned about the sounds each of these letters make and the things that begin with these letters. Our students work hard practicing writing and making these letters with playdough, popsicle sticks and yarn. We will continue to learn new letters in November.

<u>Math:</u> The students have been introduced to numbers 0-5 and have been busy counting with 1:1 correspondence to 5. Students will continue to focus on identifying the numbers and practicing the one to one correspondence for each number.

<u>Science</u>: Our students enjoyed using their 5 senses-See, Hear, Smell, Taste and Touch to explore and learn about the world around them. We discovered the different taste of foods-sour, sweet, salty, bitter. We explored different smells, some good smells like chocolate and flowers, some bad smells like coffee and garbage.

<u>Social Studies:</u> We will begin our interdisciplinary unit, *All About Us* and will focus on our unique selves with our own abilities, characteristics, interest and feelings. In addition, students will explore and learn about their roles in both their family and classroom communities.
