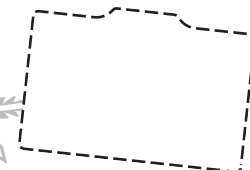
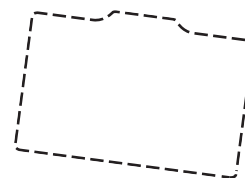
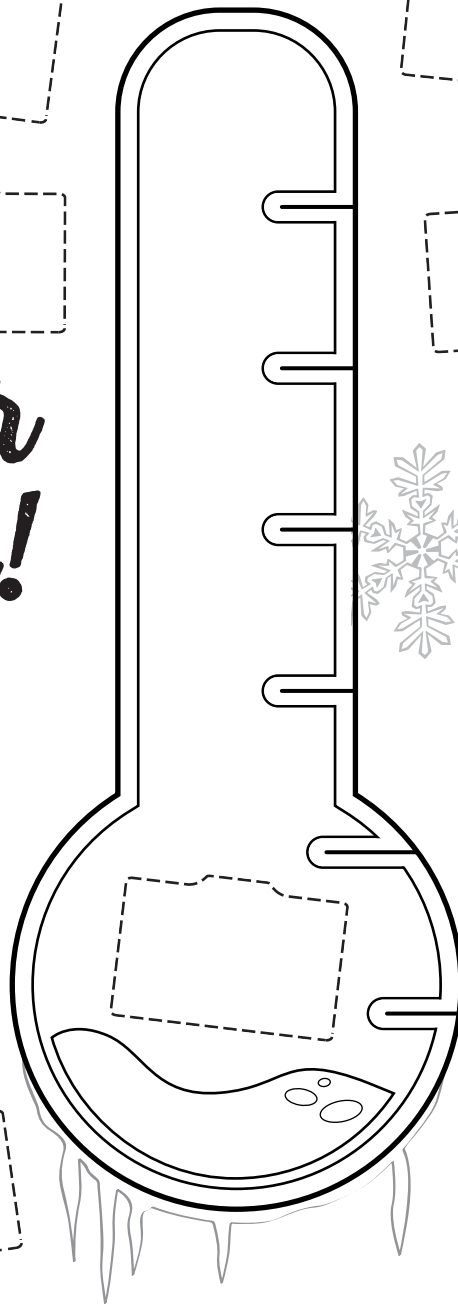
BOX TOP DOS AND DON'TS

- **DO** check the expiration date. We do not get credit for expired box tops.
- **DO** trim your box tops but leave the expiration date visible.
- **DO** send your box tops to the school as often as possible.
- **DO** tape or glue your box tops to the collection sheets.
- **DO** write your child's name and their class on all collection sheets.
- **DON'T** staple your box tops to the collection sheets.
- **DON'T** cut off the expiration date from your box tops. Date must be clearly visible.
- **DON'T** turn in expired box tops. We do not get credit if they are expired.
- **DON'T** turn in UPC barcodes or labels from other school fundraising programs.

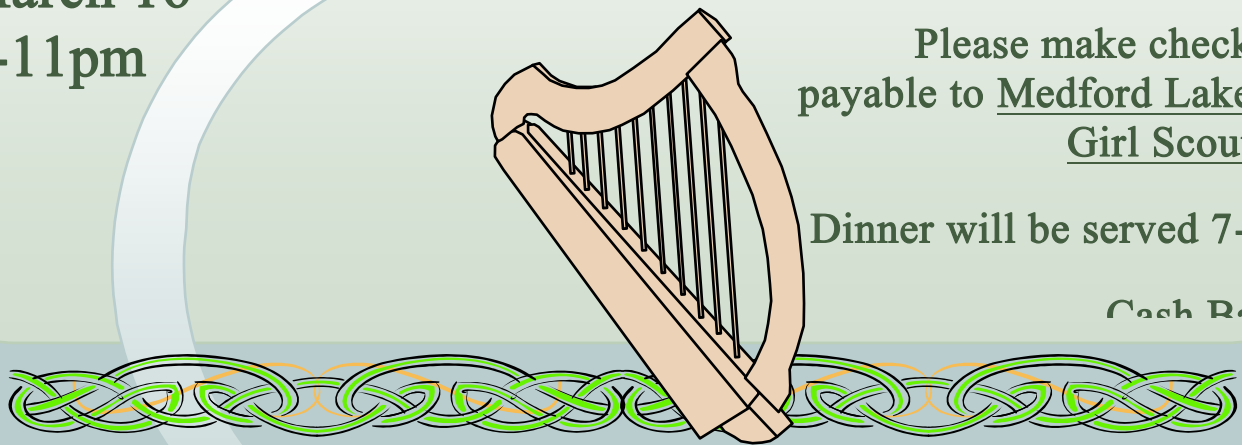
