Daily Temperature Screening Protocols

NYS Department of Health and NYS Education Department require that daily temperature screenings take place for staff and students. It is recommended that this takes place at home before reporting to school.

- Parents are to ensure that they take their child's temperature each morning and complete an electronic temperature screening and questionnaire form attesting that their child's temperature is BELOW 100.0 degrees and your child is not exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Students who have not submitted a daily temperature screening and questionnaire form electronically, will be denied entry to class until the student is screened at school.
- Any student who has a temperature of 100 degrees or more, or any symptom of COVID-19 will be isolated and a parent/guardian or emergency contact must come pick up the child.
- The district has purchased the ezSCRN program for parents to use for daily screening. ezSCRN is both Ed Law 2-d and FERPA compliant and is available as an app for iPhone (Android coming soon) or can be accessed on the web at app.ezscrn.com.
- Parents will receive an email invitation and password to log in to ezSCRN.
- Video on how to use ezSCRN directions for use (Once you receive your email invitation) and password, parents can practice filling it out before Monday. Do not select "create an account", once you receive invite and password you simply log in.)

Tips for Parents:

- \Rightarrow Leave a thermometer in a common location every night as a morning reminder.
- \Rightarrow Be familiar with the list of symptoms to look out for on a daily basis and ask your child how they are feeling each morning.
- \Rightarrow Please be sure that your emergency contacts are up to date in eSchoolData (Parent Portal)
