

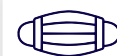

## Return to Learn



### SCEC COVID Mitigation List

- Everyone will wear a mask in SCEC buildings
- Each teacher has a sanitation packet with Lysol, sanitizer, wipes, masks & gloves
- New HVAC air filters installed in every building
- Sanitation pumps installed in each building and throughout the district
- Masks purchased (kid-sized and adult-sized)
- Sanitizing sprayers are being used
- Buses are cleaned before and after each route
- Nurses and bus drivers will check temperatures at bus stops & upon entry
- Students enter & exit separate doors (based on mode of transportation)
- SCEC supports and encourages 6 feet of social distancing at all times
- Classrooms have been measured, for maximum capacity
- Desk shields are available
- Special Education Dept has specialized PPE for students & teachers
- Mask Breaks (twice a day)
- Bathroom breaks (twice a day)
- Bathrooms have an "Accountability List" on each door (completed hourly)
- "High Traffic" areas are being cleaned regularly
- Elementary students will eat meals in classrooms
- Secondary students will be spread throughout the building to eat with social distance
- Safety signage is posted throughout ALL buildings



### What If?

- **If your child feels ill, or is symptomatic before they leave home...**  
keep them home, notify the school and contact a healthcare provider.
- **If your child arrives at the bus stop with a temperature of higher than 98.6 degrees...**  
you will be notified, the school will be notified, and arrangements will be made with you to transport the student home safely.
- **If your student is exposed to another ill student...**  
contact tracing will be done, parent(s) will be notified, student(s) will be sent home to quarantine.
- **If your student begins to feel ill while in school...**  
they will be directed to the nurse's office for further assessment and parent notification.
- **Students who are COVID positive should NOT come to school.**  
Parents are to report a positive COVID diagnosis to the school's administration/office staff.
- **If your child's sibling (who lives in the same home), has COVID (but your child does not)...**  
your child must quarantine and notify the school.
