First Grade



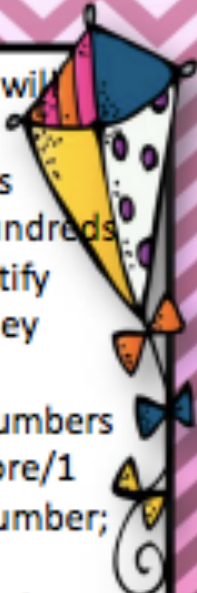
In writing we are writing our very own series books. We are creating a pretend character, giving the character adventures in more than one booklet, revising across books and finally creating our very own boxed set of stories.

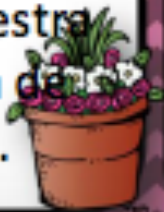

Primer Grado



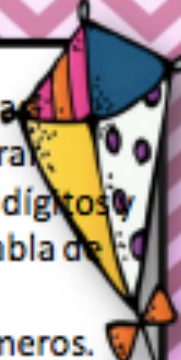

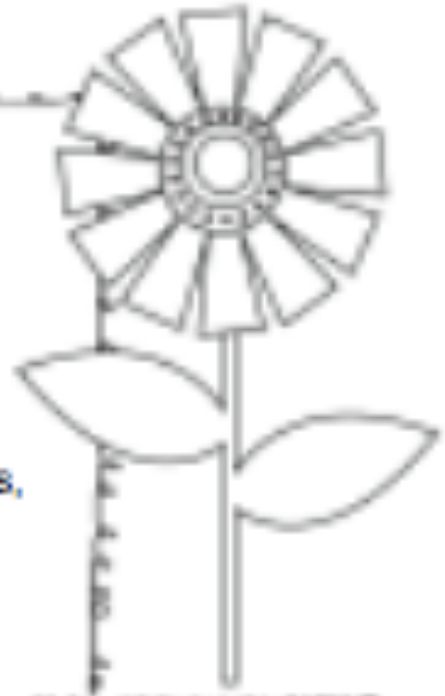

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Science

Students will be learning about Ecosystems Restoration. In this unit, students take on the role of ecologists to investigate this question and figure out what can be done to return the ecosystem to its original healthy state. As ecologists working with Natural Resources Rescue, an organization dedicated to protecting Earth's fragile ecosystems, students work to explain the anchor phenomenon: that jaguars, sloths, and cecropia trees in a reforested section of a Costa Rican rain forest are not growing and thriving. In order to understand what's causing the problem, students explore what it means to grow and how living things get the matter and energy they need to grow.

This Week's Focus

Reading- *All classes in 5th grade will be focusing on Unit 2: Tackling Complexity: Raising the Level of Nonfiction Text.

Writing- * All classes in 5th grade will be focusing on unit 2: Lens of History. Students will create research reports connected to Social Studies content of the Civil Rights Movement, immigration, and Westward Expansion.

Math-- In math students will continue to enhance their math skills by getting a head start for 6th grade now. 5th grade mathematicians will be comparing and ordering integers and learning about rational numbers on the coordinate plane. They will examine ratios, rates and ~~percents~~. While at the same time understand division of fractions and dividing whole numbers by fractions.

Social Studies- All classes in 5th grade will be focusing on the study of the Western Hemisphere cultures. Students will be asked to reflect on and develop an understanding of the unit as they focus on the essential question of, "How do key forces and events shape nations?"
