Boys Swimming Discussion:

- As of last Friday, 23 of the 31 schools that offer boys swimming will have a pool facility on/after January 4th. There are a total of ten merged boys swim programs
- The NFHS and state association have adopted guidelines for virtual meets
- All three conferences supported moving forward with virtual meets for boys swimming
