Parents of sophomores, juniors and seniors

On Wednesday, December 6, from 8:20 until 11:00 A.M. seniors, juniors and sophomores of Delone Catholic will have the opportunity to take the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) provided we have at least 10 students registered to take the test. Financial restraints placed on our Defense Department have made this directive necessary. Options will be explored should we not have the necessary number of students sign up.

The ASVAB is a series of twelve (12) tests used to measure a students' ability in various areas of learning and is an instrument used by the armed forces for military recruiting. For an individual who is considering military service taking the ASVAB is the first step toward qualifying. The ASVAB will provide scores on tests necessary to qualify for enlistment options offered by the various services.

This series of tests can also help students to learn more about themselves and the world of work as well as explore occupations in line with their interests and abilities. Taking the test in no way obligates students to join the military or meet with one of their representatives.

In order for students to register for the test, a parent must complete the form below and have their son/daughter return it to their homeroom teacher by FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 17.
