April 7, 2022 7:30 am

Attendees: Last, Maier, Vellon, Xenakis, Coniglio, Hattenrath, Calder

- **OORS update:** Infractions have been low and decreased significantly. This shows tier one supports are in place. There has been a few Covid cases entered;
- **Drill update:** One lockdown out of compliance as of 3/15/22; By the end of the year there should be 2 lockdowns and 2 evacuation drills
- **Covid-19 update:** Increase in covid cases; Letters have gone out to the community when there is a positive case. Entire classes get kits when another person in the classroom tests positive for Covid. Protocols are the same. There is a rise in cases. Maier questioned the in school testing schedule. Vellon stated that due to testing the days of the weekly testing were changed.

**Building Update:** We have 6 air conditioners being replaced April 8, 2022 and installed on April 13, 2022. One of the air conditioners are going into the classroom #107.

- **Other concerns:**

1. “L” building Key plan for Malik and Domenech will be a sign out book; Coniglio will replace the signs on the doors
2. Kindergarten yard signs for no trespassing will be replaced with translation signs
3. Clubs are starting in the middle school and safety is first; Students should be given a pass from the assigned teacher to show to the supervising staff for lunch and/or recess. All students will have to sign out in a sign out book for the cafeteria.
4. Morning arrival supervision will need to increase due to the nicer weather and students arriving early. We want to be proactive and have a rotation of staff in the mornings at around 7:45am
