

SCEC Instructional Options for Students During COVID-19

The opening of schools is guided by information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Indiana State Department of Health, and the Local Board of Health. To accommodate students and families who cannot or choose not to return to school in person, the School City of East Chicago will offer the following options:



One of these options must be selected for a semester commitment during registration.

**Plan A - Regular School Day
Schedule (Attendance on
Campus 5 days a week)**

**Plan B - ELearning
(Attendance Online during
the Regular School Day)**

Plan B - ELearning



- Attendance five days a week
- Assignments are aligned to the Indiana Academic Standards for each grade level.
- Academic achievement and advancement will be measured using the same standards and grading scales as traditional students.
- **Truancy Interventions for three days of missed assignments**
- Student grades will be calculated based on performance in all academic areas. Letter grades will be assigned.
- Students will participate in local and state assessments to determine educational needs.
- Technology tools (CANVAS or Zoom) will be used during lessons during this regular schedule to permit E-Learning students to participate simultaneously.
- Paras will be assigned to classes to monitor and assist students with assignments
- Instructional framework will remain the same: I Do, We Do, and They Do (gradual release)
- Provide online learning-specific professional learning for educators.
- CANVAS Professional development for parents
