Dear Parents and Guardians:

To help maintain a safe and healthy learning environment, GGUFSD will be following the New York State Department of Health recommendations by <u>requiring a daily COVID-19 Health</u> <u>Screening for each student for completion before the start of each school day.</u>

Parents and guardians **must** complete this digital Health Screening Questionnaire each day your child is scheduled to enter the school building by following the directions below. Once you have accessed the questionnaire, you will see that it is provided in English, Spanish, and Haitian Creole, by clicking in the upper right-hand corner.

If this **mandatory** health assessment is not completed at home, students will be required to report directly to the nurse's office for screening upon arrival at their school. Screenings at schools will be treated confidentially. If you cannot access the Health Screening Questionnaire electronically, the nurse's office will provide your child with paper copies to bring home and use until you have received the technical assistance needed to access the electronic version successfully.

Please be advised that any student with a fever of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit, or more significant, or who responds "*Yes*" to any of the questions in the Health Screening, should <u>not</u> be present in the school. Also, students will not be permitted on a school bus if they are symptomatic.
