## Questions you can ask any admissions rep:

- 1. Financial Aid: Are all applicants considered for available scholarships automatically or is there a separate system?
- 2. How many years is housing guaranteed?
- 3. Most schools post the 6 year graduation rate, what's the 4 year rate?
- 4. How easy is it to cross register, ie art classes for a psych major?
- 5. When are internships available and how are they publicized? Do you need to create an account with career services?
- 6. Is tutoring available for students? a writing lab?
- 7. How does "demonstrated interest" play into the application process? Is this an important variable and what factors go into making that determination?
- 8. Are some high school extra-curricular more valued than others? If so what would be something the school is looking for? How about community service?
- 9. How would you describe the schools culture?
- 10. When does a student have to declare a major?
- 11. Are some majors unavailable after freshman year? Art/portfolio? Education?
