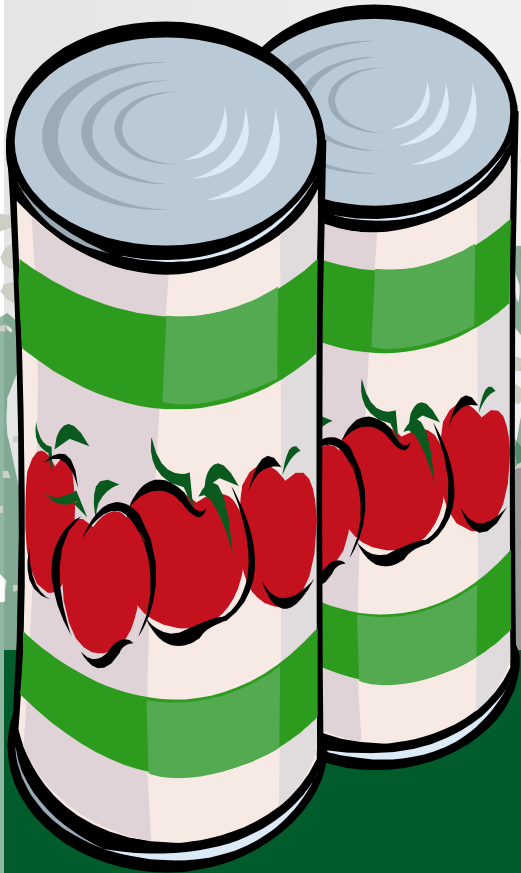
When: Monday, January 14th to Friday, February 8, 2019

- Valentine's Day Dance (7:00P.M.-9:00P.M.)



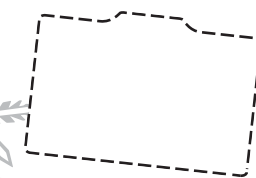
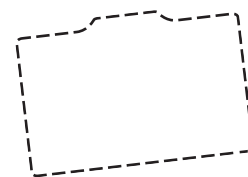
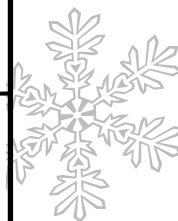
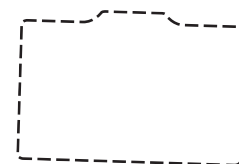
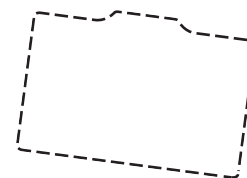
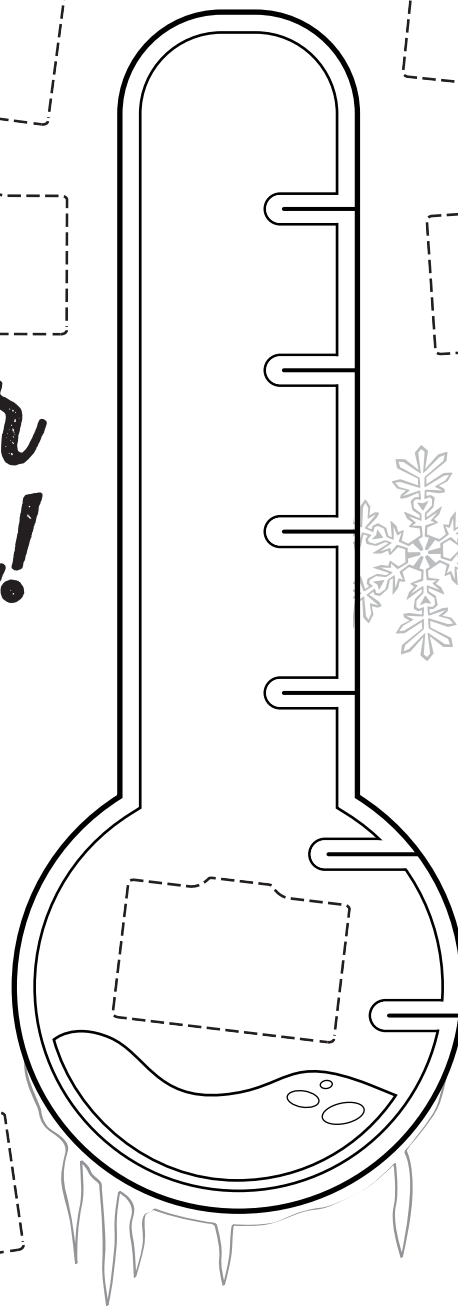
BOX TOP DOS AND DON'TS
