## WHATIS PHONICS?

Phonics instruction helps children learn the relationships between the letters of written language and the sounds of spoken language. Children are taught, for example, that the letter $n$ represents the sound /n/ and that it is the first letter in words such as nose, nice, and new.In K-2 most classes are using the FUNDATIONS Phonics Program. This is a sample of the alphabet chart..

Some basic tips on how to help your child build phonics skills: Talk about letters and sounds
Help your child learn the names of the letters and the sounds the letters make. Turn it into a game! "I'm thinking of a letter and it makes the sound mmmmmm."

## Model finger-point reading

That means to follow the words with your finger from left to right as you read them. Your beginning reader will do the same thing for awhile.

## Practice patience!

Beginning readers may read slowly. Give your child time to decode the words, and avoid jumping in too quickly. Encourage attention to letters and sounds
If your child is stuck on a word, prompt them to look at the first letter of the word and make the letter's sound. Of course, only do this for words that can be sounded out! If the word can't be sounded out, just supply the word for them.
