Principal Ramos treated our students and staff to some delicious ice cream after a year of hard work. Well deserved! They loved their special treat!

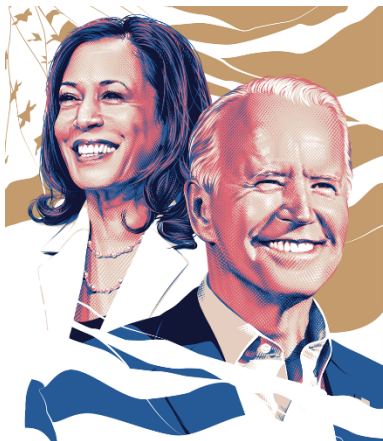
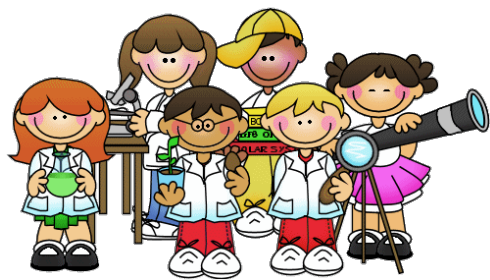

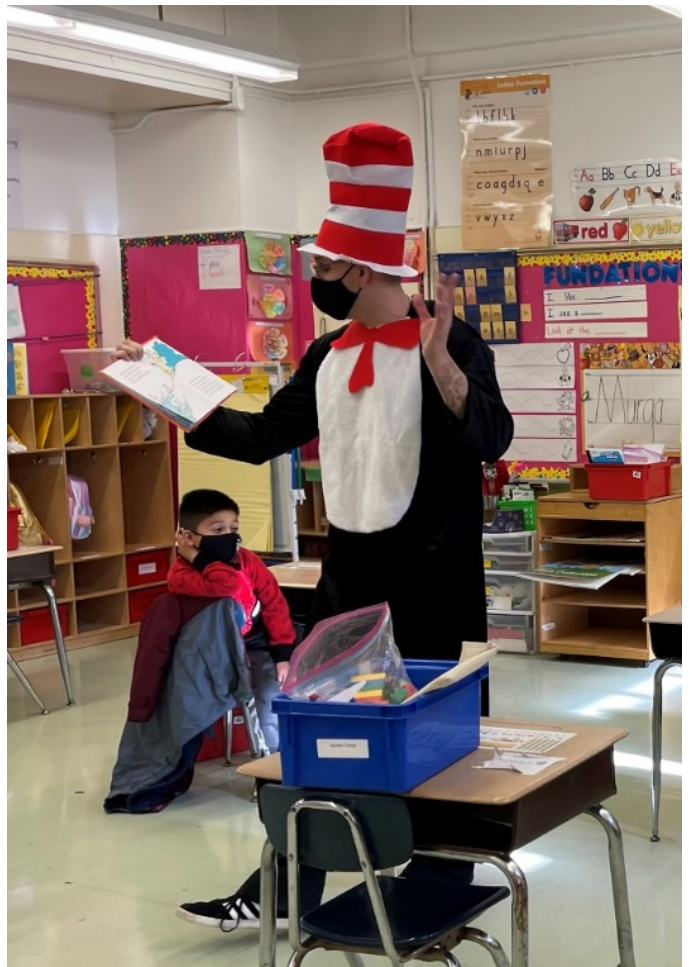
Celebrating mothers, grandmothers and anyone that stands in as a mom in our lives, by reading our memoirs; letting them know how special they are to us. Class 3-311
