6. CEP Feedback

- a. No feedback yet.
- b. Mr. Wright stated that he saw that the ESL side was good.
- c. The dates were all changed and there hasn't been any feedback.
- d. The SI is doing classroom visits at this time and they are making sure we are prepared for full closure if it has to happen. The CEP feedback teams are occupied with other priorities.
- e. CEPS that need lots of work and feedback are looked at first. Schools that have a good history are placed lower on priority.
- f. Initial approval hasn't been given and we are now at mid-year assessment.
- g. Paley has been stalling as much as she can as it is difficult for people and fidelity can be questioned when students are not taking it in person.

7. Middle School Update

- a. No updates at this time in regard to students returning.
- b. Specialized high school test is to be given in their home schools. No real plan as to how this will happen at this time for our school though we can accommodate, there are schools that only have middle and HS open.
- c. Students still have to apply to take the test.
- d. Mr. Wright anticipates that this may be changing and will probably change the discussion around school opening for middle schools. If kids can take a three- hour test, why can't they attend in person school.
- e. Parents are already upset by policies being suggested that will weight priority for equity gaps.
- f. Info will be coming in about High School Open Houses. This will be interesting and possibly controversial due to no testing ELA and MATH and inconsistent grading policies across districts.
- g. NEST and Horizon host open houses for potential 6th graders. Had an online open house in September. Horizon open house is today at 5:30 for middle school. All 5th grade Horizon in Queens is invited.
- h. The plan was for middle to return in person, changed get made to the schedules when teachers get exemptions to work from home. Due to this, changes have to take place for middle school. They were able to have a special ed teacher in an ICT class in a new position. Start the changes while kids are remote and then it will be easier to ease in when students return in person.
- i. Are trying to clean up the schedule for teachers. Framing it for kids that schedules change in the middle of the year anyway so prepping for what high school will be like. Dedicated teacher for at home and one for in school.
