

What is the NAMI Basics Education Program?

NAMI Basics is a *free*, *6 session* course designed for parents and other family caregivers of children and adolescents with mental, emotional and/or behavioral difficulties. You will learn the facts about mental health conditions, treatment, resources and how best to support your child at home, at school and when they're getting medical care. The course provides critical strategies for taking care of your child, communication, problem solving and learning the ropes of recovery.

Last year, 99% of participants told us they would recommend the program to other parents.


