Option #1 - Core Courses with PCPS Staff



Credit Recovery Only

These classes are for students who failed core courses during the regular school year. The course will allow students to recover content and meet course requirements for graduation. These courses will be offered face-to-face based on student enrollment.

These classes are for highly motivated students who are able to self-pace during the summer. Students may enroll in only one online course during the summer session unless they receive permission from their administrator. Students should plan to devote at least 4 hours per day per class to working on an online class. A reliable internet connection with the capability to stream video is mandatory. ***Students and parents must attend orientation.***

PHS Online Economics & Personal Finance

In this course required for graduation, students will learn how to make informed decisions related to career exploration, budgeting, banking, credit, insurance, taxes, saving & spending, investing, managing debt, retirement, inheritance, and living independently. This is a FULL YEAR course compacted into 7 weeks, so it **REQUIRES** a commitment to doing work on a daily basis to finish on time. Course materials will be available starting June 1st.

Economics and Personal Finance culminates with a financial literacy test (WISE Test) that serves as a CTE certification toward graduation. This test must be taken at PHS. The test is an integral part of the class. During each testing window, the test may be taken up to three times in order to pass.

WISE Test dates: July 21, July 25, & July 27

Online Health/PE for Grade 9 and 10

Students are required to successfully complete the course content and plan/implement a personal wellness/activity plan. Seventy hours of physical activity plus the equivalent of 70 hours of online health instruction are necessary. The final grade will be based on written assessments and the quantity/quality of physical activity. This course will be completed in a virtual format, no required in person attendance. The course must be started no later than May 16th to ensure that students have enough time to complete the course requirements by July 15. Students and their parents will be required to attend an orientation.

Driver Education Classroom

This will be a combination of online and face to face zoom time. Students will need to have access to reliable internet and a computer. Students will need to log the time they work on their own as well as the zoom meetings. This time must be a minimum of 36 hours.

Course Session: June 14-June 30. The course will begin June 14 at 1:00 p.m. with a google meet. There will be a daily google meet requirement for the class. We will finish class on June 30. The daily google meet will take place at 1:00 pm Monday through Thursday. Attendance will be mandatory!! Plan on each meeting being 60-90 minutes in length. **This does not include behind the wheel.**
