TEST CONTENT The High School Placement Test (HSPT) will be administered. The test is designed to measure scholastic aptitude in verbal and non-verbal abilities, and achievement in reading, mathematics and language.

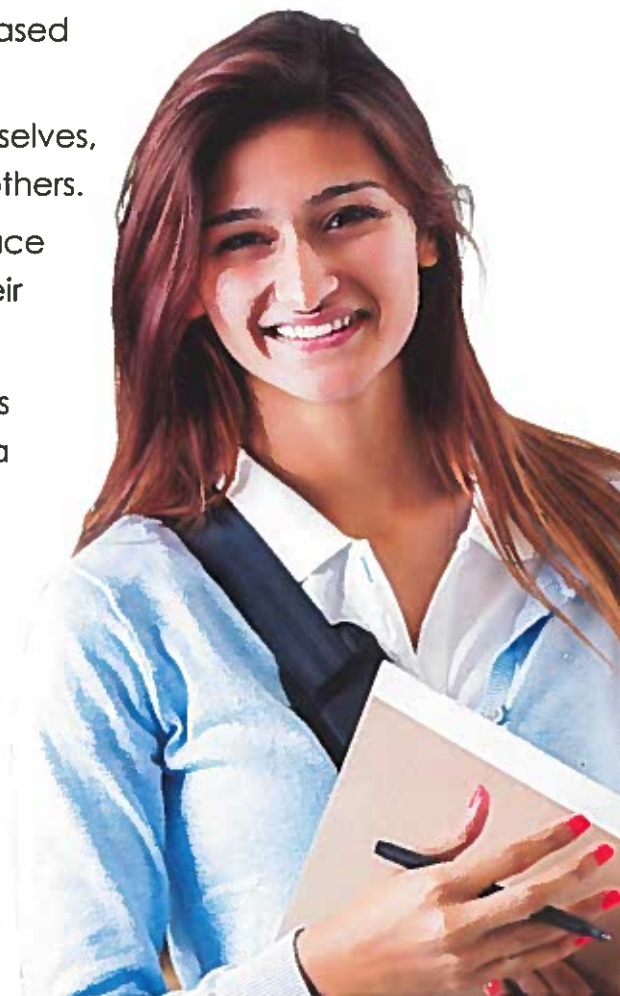
