**I. CALL TO ORDER** – The special meeting of February 26, 2019, was called to order by Lee Bridgewater, Chair, at 7:11 p.m. in the WHS library.

- III. BUDGET DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP: Superintendent Patricia A. Ciccone presented the 2019-20 budget in a PowerPoint presentation. She pointed out what drives the budget and how the budget guidelines align with the school and budget goals. It is a zero based budget approach, comprised of teacher requests and administrator requests which are carefully reviewed and recommended by the Superintendent. As is always the case, the Superintendent stated that salaries and benefits are the largest segment of the budget. Because AFT negotiations are still pending, there is a placeholder for that. Purchased services and Transportation figures are down as well as Supplies and Utilities. She said there are current legislative actions that affect the budget. Superintendent Ciccone said that she will be in Hartford on Friday for the applicable legislative hearing on Bill (7150). The slides showed actual figures for salaries, benefits, purchased services, transportation, tuition, supplies and equipment. This budget does include 3 positions reflective of current student needs. Mr. Perreault pointed out the last three years of low budget increases and questioned if our needs are being met. The Superintendent commented that despite tight management, we have enough to support our known needs. The Board will approve the Superintendent's proposed budget at the March Board of Education meeting. A date for the Board of Finance presentation for both operating budgets and CIP has not yet been confirmed by the Board of Finance. The Board Chair expressed appreciation to Superintendent Ciccone for the excellent presentation.
