  - Shoutout to Megan, Arcelia and Katherine for organizing the Thanksgiving food drive which helped to feed 30 families
  - Winter Coat Drive Ms Garcia, a 3rd grade teacher, launched a Donors Choose project to acquire winter coats for PS139 kids. It was funded within 24 hours! We now have 32 coats, 48 hats, 48 pairs of gloves so if you need a winter coat or know someone who does, they are available for people who need them.
