WHEREAS, the Board would like to delay the implementation of these projects until a comprehensive master capital plan has been developed for the District;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby determines that the funds in the voter approved 2012-2013 school budget for the following capital projects: replacement of auditorium seats (\$60,000) and installation of motorized gate and fence at Gate #1 (\$60,000), shall not utilized for such projects and shall, instead, be returned to the General Fund from the Capital Fund by June 30, 2013: and

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board directs that the replacement of auditorium seats and the installation of a motorized gate and fence are to be considered by the Facilities Committee for possible inclusion in a more comprehensive master capital plan developed during the 2013-2014 school year.
