What is the role of the faculty mentor?

- 1. Mentors will help the student:
 - Stay on task through discussions at regular meetings, reading of the journal, and occasional calls to on-site mentor (if applicable). See requirements above and rubric for benchmarks and guidance for both the teacher and the student.
 - Expand the project, see new opportunities, and deal with challenges.
 - Find new resources
 - Improve the journal (see some suggestions for prompts below)
 - Perfect the presentation
- 2. Mentors will attend and take notes at the student's final evaluation.
- 3. Mentors will complete progress forms, and interim and final evaluations on the student's WISE project.
- 4. Mentors will stay in contact with the WISE coordinator, especially if their student is in danger of failing WISE.
