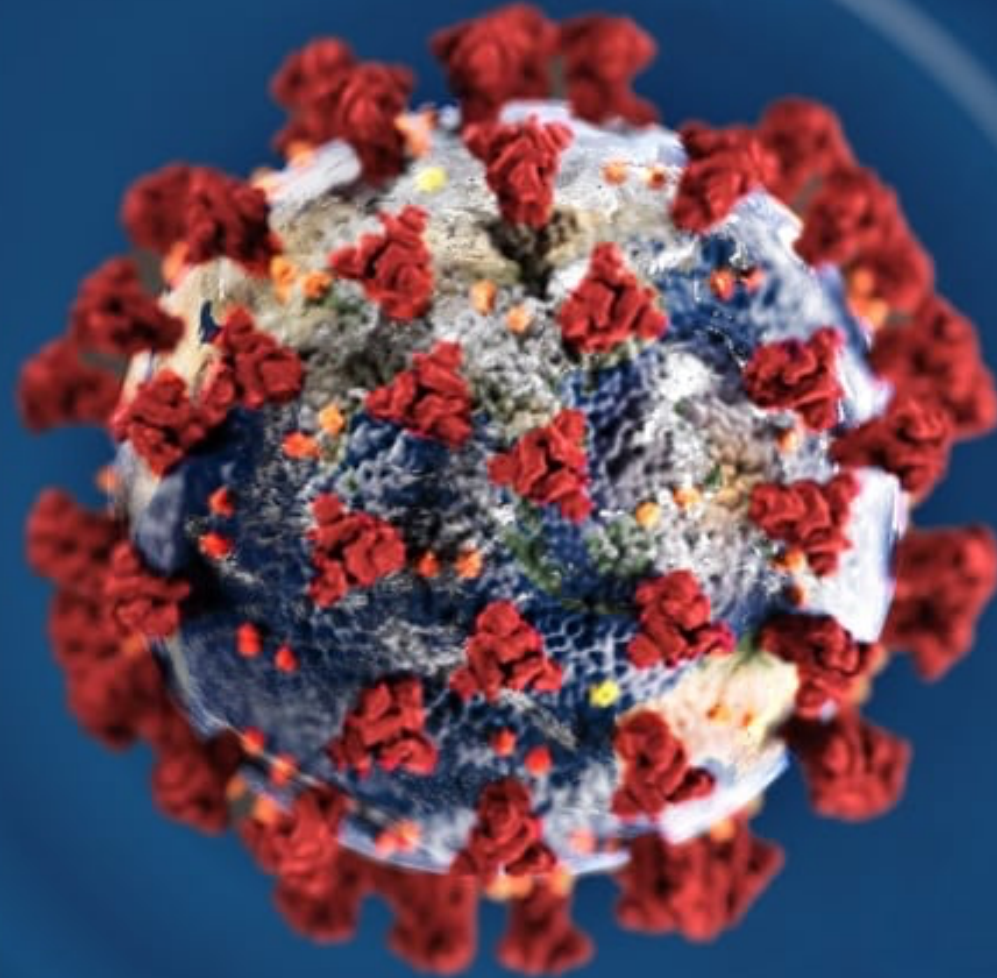


My Story About Coronavirus




This is a story about

People should wash their hands really well and often. When you wash your hands you should sing “Happy Birthday” two times to make sure they are clean.




The Coronavirus has been making many people sick. If people are close together in the same place, it is easier for the virus to spread.
