Make the most of the lazy, hazy days of summer by grabbing a good book and get lost in a whole new world or point of view! But remember, one person's opinion of a good book may not be your idea of a great read. Never fear, just follow the three reading tips I've listed below and you'll be sure to find a book that is "Just Right" for you!

I. <u>The Five Finger Method</u> - read any page of a book that interests you. If there are five words you can't pronounce, or whose meaning you do not know, this book is not for you. You want a fun and interesting read not a "let me stop every five minutes to figure out what I'm reading" read!



- II. <u>The "Window Shopping" Method</u> Read the front and back covers of a book along with the first couple of pages to see if your "sold" on the read!
- III. <u>The Top Twenty Method</u> If a book doesn't interest you after reading 20 pages, don't force yourself to continue reading it because it will probably just put you to sleep! You can always pick it up another time. Remember, as you grow, your interests change and you become stronger. That goes for reading, too!
