TRANSPORTATION TO CHILD CARE FACILITIES

In lieu of the transportation otherwise provided between home and school, the district will provide transportation to any child attending kindergarten through eighth grade between the

child's school and before and/or after-school child care locations in accordance with the district's

transportation mileage limitations.

Child care location shall mean a place, other than the student's home, where care for less

than 24 hours a day is provided on a regular basis for a student who attends school within the district, provided that such place is situated within the district. This definition includes, but is not

limited to, a variety of child care services such as day care centers, family day care homes and in-

home care by non-relatives.

Transportation to / from child care centers and school age child care programs licensed or

registered pursuant to New York State Social Services law § 390 shall be provided anywhere within the boundaries of the District. However, transportation to / from all other child care

locations shall be limited to those within the student's attendance zone. Changes may not be made

on a daily basis. Child care locations must not be more than 15 miles from the student's school of

attendance.

All child care transportation requests shall be made in writing and received by the

Director of Transportation no later than the April 1st preceding the beginning of the next school year. If a student moves into the district later than April 1st, the request should be received within

thirty days of establishing residence in the district, but preferably no later than August 1st. If there

is a need to change a child care location during the school year, a written request must be

submitted to the Director of Transportation at least five days before the requested change. The district will accommodate such requests in accordance with the law and this policy provided that:

1. a route in the area exists,

2. space is available on the bus, and

3. the district incurs no additional cost as a result of the change
