1.	$\cdot$ Urban Academy had an available total cash balance of \$253,284 at the end of May 2015 reflected across all funds. It also holds a \$450,000 reserved certificate of deposit set aside as required in the FY16 lease agreement. $\Box$	
2.	· Urban Academy has received additional amounts from State Sources during	
	this fiscal year of \$48,157 calculated at June 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2014 in school fiscal year 2014-2015. Recently, in May 2015, the school received an additional payment of \$12,940 from state special education funds earned in the 2011-2012 school year. □	
3.	· There was a balance of \$28,598 in current liabilities for general accounts payable and payroll liabilities at May 31, 2015. A portion of the liability is for payroll withholdings on the last day of the month which are not paid until the first days of the next month, thus they are reflected on the current balance sheet. $\Box$	

4.	· Urban Academy has a current year overall audited fund balance of \$1,109,570
at Ju	ne $30^{th}$ , 2014 which includes its investments in fixed assets. $\Box$

2.	$\cdot$ The mid-year budget revision is based on 281.72 ADM (January Actual ADM) and was adopted at the March 2015 board meeting. $\Box$
3.	$\cdot$ A proposed FY15 Final Budget revision has been created for presentation at the May 2015 Board meeting based on 281.24 ADM. $\Box$
4.	$\cdot$ Revenue activity listed on the Summary Income Statement are reflections of current year actual amounts and do not include calculations for revenue earned during the school year but not yet received. These amounts are calculated at year end as part of the audit preparation process. $\Box$
5.	$\cdot$ Expenditures included in the Summary Income Statement are reported on actual activity and known accounts payable activity. Amounts unpaid but included in the statements will be paid for in the following month. Accounts Payable and Salary Accrual amounts are calculated at year end as part of the audit process. $\Box$
