School Responsibilities

Yorktown Elementary will:

- ❖ Provide students with a quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables participating children to work toward the Indiana Career Readiness Standards.
- Ensure all students will receive at least 90 minutes of Language Arts and 60 minutes of Math instruction daily from classroom teachers.
- ❖ Provide Language Arts and Math instruction that is geared to their academic level either through flexible grouping or differentiated instruction of grade level standards. Placement and instructional levels are based on assessment results.
- Ensure all students in RtI intervention services will receive small group remedial Language Arts and/or Math instruction from their classroom teacher or a highly qualified Title I paraprofessional.
- ❖ Provide students in grades three to five at least 90 minutes per week using a variety of researched-based practices and programs such as Read-Live and Making Connections. These programs along with direct instruction remediate students based upon skill deficits in Language Arts and focus on improving reading fluency and comprehension. Students are supervised by a highly qualified Title I paraprofessional or licensed classroom teacher during RtI.
- ❖ Hold general education meetings at teacher or parent requests based upon academic concerns and/or movement to Tier III in the RtI process. The school maintains a list of available tutors for parents if requested.
- Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress.
- ❖ Provide parents with access to contact teachers and all paraprofessionals that work with their child. (765-759-2770)
- Provide parents with opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's classroom and to observe activities.
