
One of my students' all-time favorite activities is to sit down & play board games together. They loved it so much that I knew I had to give them the opportunity to create their own.


Encourage your own kiddos to put their "steam" skills to the test by inviting them to design, map out & build their very own original board game! Each game is guaranteed to be unique!




- I. CUT OUT THE "PATHWAY" TILES AND GLUE THEM ONTO YOUR BOARD.

- 5. TITLE YOUR GAME & WRITE DIRECTIONS EXPLAINING HOW TO PLAY IT.




















