Principal's Message

elone Catholic High School continues to grow. Our doors will open in August with 650 students filling our hallways and classes. As they follow in the footsteps of the thousands of alumni that have gone before them, they will tread upon a new floor in the cafeteria and the two hallways leading to the cafeteria.

The project began this summer with the asbestos abatement of the existing tile floor. The area was sealed as the floor tile was removed. Days later, the flooring company took over to prepare the cement for the adhesion of the new poured floor. I know that the maintenance department is delighted since floor tiles will not have to be replaced. That task always involved many steps as the new tiles were $12 \ge 12$ and the existing tiles were $9 \ge 9$.

The other summer project included the replacement of the bleachers in the Sheppard Gym. Black and gold emanates from every corner of the gym; as our ADA approved bleachers now have aisles with railings and areas designated for wheelchairs. Our seating capacity declined to accommodate these changes.

Delone Catholic is changing! But as we change we still remain much the same. Our academic program remains strong. We are proud of our senior student who scored a perfect 1600 on the SAT's. We are proud of the scholarship moneys that our graduating seniors were awarded from colleges and universities. We are proud of the 93% of the graduating class of 2004 who are continuing their education beyond the halls of Delone Catholic High School.

Delone Catholic High School remains challenged to provide the necessary facilities for our students. The Building and Grounds Committee in conjunction with the Development Committee will continue to investigate future plans for expansion. A new chapel, auditorium, classroom space, music facilities, weight room, woodshop and other areas



As our enrollment has grown and also our sports program, Delone Catholic reached the point of time that this one position needed to become two. The Board approved the recommendation. Mr. Frew chose to continue as Athletic Director and teach physical education classes on a part-time basis. Mr. Alan Felix is now our Dean of Students. Alan has established a wonderful reputation throughout the community first as a 1993 graduate involved in many of our sports programs and now as the varsity baseball coach. Alan graduated from Shepherd College. For the past five years he has pursued course work at McDaniel College for a Master's Degree in Special Education. He worked at the Paradise School as part of the Emotional Support Team.

New Faculty Members

The search for new teachers began in the spring. Mr. Sagedy was retiring so the call went out for the math position. Miss Stacey Wingert will join our faculty. Stacey has a BS from York College in Mathematics. She then attended Wilson College to earn the credits necessary in education to become certified.

In March, the Board of Directors approved an additional position in the Social Studies Department. Mr. John Bennett, a graduate from York College earning a Bachelor's Degree in Social Studies, will begin his first teaching experience at Delone Catholic. He is a Hanover native and is very pleased to return to the area for this new assignment.

After two years, Mrs. Tropp decided that the drive from Lebanon each day was too time consuming. This opening in Spanish returned to Delone Catholic a 1992 graduate, Mr. Jim Murren. Jim graduated from Penn State University with a Bachelor's Degree and continued to earn a Master Degree at the University of Pennsylvania. Jim then devoted two years as a Peace Corps volunteer in Honduras. He developed his skills in Spanish fully immersed in the culture of the country.

The Science Department experienced the loss of two teachers. Miss Pinkos, as a faculty member and department chair, decided to embrace the challenge of teaching a new curriculum. She will begin the 2004 school year as the teacher of Chemistry. The two positions in the department enabled us to welcome teachers who will teach both Biology and Physical Science. Mrs. Nicole Gipe graduated from Elizabethtown College with a degree in Biology. She is currently enrolled in Millersville University to complete the necessary education curriculum.

Our second teacher in the Science Department returns to her Alma Mater. Miss Crystal Zeigler, a 1996 graduate, continued her education at the University of Delaware earning a BA in Biology and earned her teacher certification at Shippensburg University. Although a new teacher, Crystal will be able to show Nicole around the school as they share classes and a classroom.

The part-time position of Technology Coordinator was added by the Board this year. Beginning in September, Mr. Adam Atwell will devote fifteen hours a week to the technology program at Delone Catholic keeping all our hardware, software and network running smoothly. Adam is currently working on his graduation project from Carroll Community College at Delone Catholic. He will be totally knowledgeable of our system before he begins in September. Adam is continuing his education at the University of Maryland in Baltimore.

As a member of the U.S. handcycling team in 2001, Greg won his first world championship, earning a gold medal in the team time trial and a silver medal in the open road race in the



After a brief, but moving ceremony, participants were invited into the old gym for a variety of light snacks and refreshments. The semi-circle shaped garden is partitioned by a concrete walk that forms a cross. Around the perimeter of each section are 32 memorial plaques. A thirty-third plaque is located on a center pedestal upon which stands an angel overlooking the garden.
