Project-Based Assignments: (please select one to go with mandated book)

- Comic Strip- Create a comic strip retelling the story you have read.
- ❖ Diorama- Pick an important scene from the book and represent it in a shoe box. You must also submit a written paragraph or more consisting of five to seven sentences describing the scene and whether or not you and the character would be friends. Why or why not?
- ❖ Cereal Box- Create a cereal box based on your book. Name and decorate the cereal box to represent the book you have chosen. Include things that are really on a cereal box. Everything should have to do with the book. Do not forget information like the title, author, main events/summary, characters and/or facts.
