How to Use TumbleBooks in Your **School and Classroom**

CONGRATULATIONS! YOUR SCHOOL NOW HAS A TUMBLEBOOKLIBRARY SUBSCRIPTION!

You're joining thousands of schools around the world who are offering their students and teachers unlimited access to this great resource.

"We use it in classrooms for the whole class to see and hear a book. As well as independently in literacy stations. In the Title 1 programs, we send home bookmarks with password for parents to use at home with their children. We educate parents on how and why to use TumbleBooks at each parent meeting. GETTING STARTED

Ok. You now have the subscription. What's the best way to get started?

- 1. Add your subscription's unique TumbleBookLibrary direct link to your website!
 - The link can appear ANYWHERE on your school's website! (Or anywhere on your District's website if it's a district-wide purchase).
- 2. Sign-in to your subscription, and visit the TumbleAdmin* section of TumbleBookLibrary to find our wide selection of exciting banners and icons to use with the link!
 - *The button for TumbleAdmin is green, and can be found in the footer of the website.
- 3. But how does the Link work, exactly?

Your school's unique link is a special URL that is encrypted with your account's username and password. That means that your students can access the collection with just a single click - from home and from school! There's no need to remember the username and password!

HOW TO BEST USE THE COLLECTION

INTRODUCTION

"The students love to follow along with the picture books. They love the animations, which go along with the words making it enjoyable and educational."

Use it for independent reading, group activities, story time, lessons, and more!

And, as a digital library of animated talking picture books, it has the added bonus of being accessible – 24/7 – from any device with an internet connection.

TUMBLEADMIN

Every subscription includes access to a personalized TumbleAdmin section. You can access The TumbleAdmin section anytime by signing into your TumbleBookLibrary subscription and clicking on the green button at the bottom of the home page.

The TumbleAdmin page includes your account user statistics, access to the teacher TumbleTracker portal, and marketing materials for you to use on your website and newsletters.

Note that TumbleAdmin is not password-protected as it displays NO sensitive information.

USAGE STATISTICS

TumbleBookLibrary tracks the usage statistics for every account. To see the total number of books read by your students, as well as a monthly breakdown for the last 3 years, simply click on the green TumbleAdmin button.

For school subscriptions: the Usage statistics also display the number of quizzes taken and lesson plans viewed on your account.

For School/Library partnership accounts: You'll see multiple locations listed, but the primary account holder (eg: the library) is a cumulative total of all users' activity.

TUMBLETRACKER

Your subscription includes the NEW TumbleTracker feature! Send us a list of interested teachers' email addresses to sign up! We'll send out user information for each teacher.

"At the end of every school year, we tell our student's parents and staff how many library books were borrowed and how many TumbleBooks were read on line (using our brand new TumbleTracker program) and then award the student and teacher with the most reads a certificate."

TumbleTracker lets teachers set up their students with unique IDs so that they can track their reading progress, assign books to read and quizzes to take, and even tailor assignments based on student activity.

COMMON CORE PORTAL

TumbleBooks exclusive Common Core Portal helps educators find specific lesson plans and TumbleBooks to help fulfill core level requirements.

Simply click on the Common Core link in the blue navigation bar to access the feature anytime!

The Common Core portal offers tabs for Reading: Literature, Reading: Informational Texts, and Mathematics. Within each section, we list the levels for kindergarten through grade five.

It is a great resource for guiding educators through TumbleBooks' many resources and for highlighting how the materials can be used in class lessons and activities.

TUMBLESEARCH

The top right corner of the site has a link to our TumbleSearch feature. TumbleSearch allows you to find JUST the right book for you: by subject, length, and reading levels!

In addition, our *Search By Title* and *Author* areas have an auto-fill function that help young readers find the titles they're looking for, even if they might have a hard time spelling the words correctly.

The Search By Title and Search By Author sections are great to use if you know exactly what you're looking for. Were you reading a book called "Hello Sun" last week, but can't remember where to find it? Just enter the title and it'll pop right up!

STORY BOOK OF THE DAY

Visit TumbleBookLibrary every day to see a new highlighted *Story Book of the Day*! We also highlight Graphic Novels, Non Fiction, Read Alongs, and Videos of the day!

When you log in to TumbleBookLibrary, the *Story Book of the Day* slider is at the forefront of the home page, and it rotates between the other book categories every few seconds.

Inspiration can come from many places, and we hope that our *Book of the Day* feature may help you find your new favorite read! Help you revisit an old favorite! Most of all, we hope it will help you explore everything the site has to offer.

FAVORITES AND PLAYLISTS

Have you found a book you LOVE and want to come back to it again later? Add it to Favorites by clicking on the "Add to Favorites" button beneath the book cover.



Or, do you want to set up your student with a 30 minute block of stories while you work with another student? Click the "Add to Playlist" button.

These two features are great tools for organizing your TumbleBookLibrary, and coming back to specific books later on.

Simply be aware that these featured are saved on individual computers or devices. This means that if a student makes a list on one device, they should use that device again the next time they want to see their list.

Your list of Favorites and Playlists can be accessed by clicking on the blue Favorites and Playlist links in the navigation bar at the top of the page.

Note that these Playlists are ones you make yourself! Whereas the pink Playlist category tab features over 100 pre-made Playlists created by TumbleBooks.

INDEX

The TumbleBookLibrary Index is a live list of all active titles in the collection.

The hyperlinked headings let you sort the list by Title, Author, Book Type, or AR level! There's even a "Story Books" button which allows you to pull out just the story books from the original list.

You can jump to a specific area in the list by clicking on one of the alphabet buttons. Finally, the Index also has a red speaker icon which shows you if a title includes audio narration or not. It's a great way to see – at a glance – all of our read-along story and chapter books.

TUMBLETIMES AND WORD COUNT

There are many ways in which teachers can determine the suitability of a book for their children. The length of a book is definitely one of them. TumbleBooks supports our readers' book choices by displaying both the word count and the "TumbleTime" length for each book in the collection. You can find this information on the right side of a book display page, under "Book Details".

"I like that I can search by TumbleTime to find a title that fits the topic I need and the time frame I have available"

READING LEVELS

TumbleBooks displays the pertinent reading levels for every book in the collection (where available). You'll find Accelerated Reader (A/R) and Lexile levels, and grade levels.

"Each child feels like an independent reader, regardless of the level that he/she is on."



While you'll find that the AR and Lexile levels give specific levels, the grade levels feature ranges like K-3 or 1-4. TumbleBooks' grade level ranges are based on publisher suggestions, and represent more the "interest" level than the exact "reading" level of a book.

"The fact that the levels of books available are so far-reaching makes this a wonderful site for classrooms---virtually any child can utilize the features on this site. In addition, with TumbleBookLibrary's unique talking picture book format, the range of readers to whom our books are accessible are much wider than if they were only read-on-your-own. For instance, a 1st grader can select a book beyond their independent reading level and learn and enjoy it as much as a more advanced reader. "

AR INFO

Not every book in TumbleBookLibrary has an AR level available, but for every book that is a part of the AR program, we list the applicable information for you to use in your school.

"Our students are avid readers and Accelerated Reader participants so TumbleBooks is really a great tool for them to enhance their reading and earn AR points for which they are rewarded."

The AR information includes: quiz numbers, interest level, points, and word count.

To access the AR information, simply click on the link in "Accelerated Reader: Info" under the Book Details section.

In addition to a variety of quiz lengths (there are short 5-question quizzes, longer 10-20 question quizzes), we have quizzes on comprehension, vocabulary, and other concepts.

PAIRED VIDEOS AND BOOKS

Many of our National Geographic videos are paired with TumbleBook story books (in fiction and non fiction). Working together, the informative National Geographic video and the educationally entertaining TumbleBook can help students more thoroughly understand different concepts, and see different perspectives of complex ideas.





TumbleBooks is compatible on computers and mobile devices like phones and tablets!

However, your experience on the site may differ a little based on your device. Every user logs into www.TumbleBookLibrary.com, but you should be redirected to one of our mobile websites if you're on a tablet or a phone.

COMPUTERS (PCS AND MACS):

Flash is the primary format of the content on www.TumbleBookLibrary.com which is why this site will only work on computers and browsers with an up-to-date Flash Player plugin installed.

Note that after logging in on a computer, you may see "asp.TumbleBooks.com" in the address bar. This is normal! About half of our users get redirected here. As a way to alleviate stress on our servers, we split our subscribers into two servers rather than just one.

IPAD AND ANDROID TABLETS, OR CHROMEBOOKS:

Our site is fully compatible on tablets! You would access TumbleBookLibrary on a tablet using the same method you'd use on a computer.

Except, after logging in on a tablet, you'll be directed to this URL: **www.TumbleMobile.com**.

TumbleMobile looks and works the same way as the main site, with only a few small differences: the story books are delivered in a video format (.m4v and .mp4) rather than in Flash.



APPLE IPHONES AND ANDROID SMARTPHONES:

When you log into TumbleBookLibrary on a smartphone, the experience is very different than it is on tablets and computer.

First, the URL in the address bar reads: **mobile.TumbleMobile.com**.

Second, the graphics on the site were redesigned to be easily viewable on a smaller screen. In addition, the Phone site is lighter and more intended for "on the go" reading, as it does not have the full complement of educator resources or special functions at this time.
