## **Daisy PTO Budget**

- Balance as of 9/18/23 was \$4,977.76
- As of today: \$3,965.14
  - Last meeting balances in actuals for this year included 22/23 expenses
  - These are now shown back to 22/23 where they belong
- Currently predicted 23/24 income will not cover 23/24 expenses
  - More fundraising?
    - Suggestion for Raffle baskets
      - Daisy Dash & Ice Cream Social have baskets perhaps Family Picnic
      - Previously each grade level had a theme for a basket
    - Suggestion for raffle tickets for time with teachers
    - Suggestion to reach out to Westbrook Merchants for sponsorship
  - o Cut expenditures?
    - Year end ice cream truck, ice cream social changed back to charge
- Committee chairs need to be mindful of their budgets
- Questions:
  - Income for Daisy Dash is net the expenses (not a separate line)
  - School purchases includes items such as:
    - Art frames in pit
    - Striping of playground
    - Last day of school ice cream & pizza
  - No expense for graduation this year but usually ~\$1,750
    - Ruth would still like to see a "fun" night for the fourth graders
  - Ruth guestioned what cost of book fair included
    - Scholastic no longer supplies theme
    - Last year's cost were in school purchases
  - Having everything broken out helps committee chairs
  - This year will have food service on the last day so school purchases may decrease, as not having lunch service was original reason for pizza purchase

  - Net likely ~\$700 loss

  - Proposal to expand the Daisy Dash to WMS & WHS
  - View the slides here
  - Vision has always been to promote community & wellness
  - Always included all 3 schools with messages regarding Dash
    - Would like to include them with fundraising
  - o Parent involvement has been on the decline
    - Need at least 30 volunteers on race day alone
    - Need a more dedicated committee
      - Tovah would stay as Race Director, anyone who wants to help/come on as assistant director
      - Cassie would stay on as Tech Coordinator, anyone who wants to can help/come on as assistant
      - Looking for Sponsorship, Volunteer, and Marketing Coordinator to join the committee
  - What does expansion look like:
    - Same course, held at Daisy
    - District-wide wellness challenges
    - Potential run club again (explore options due to winter weather)
    - More fundraising, more volunteers
  - Profit Proposal:

- Daisy has largest student population and expenditures of PTO
- For 2024 proposing 75% Daisy/12.5% WMS/12.5% WHS split of net profits up to \$15K; above \$15K raised 70% Daisy/15% WMS/15% WHS
- Open Floor Discussion
  - Individuals seemed supportive
  - Ruth loved idea to include past students
  - Sponsor a runner brought up as a fundraising tool
  - Expansion may open up more opportunities and different circles for sponsor donations
  - WMS is in support already
  - Jenn Fineza (WHS PTO President) will bring to WHS; WHS might use funds to sponsor a Senior with scholarship funds
  - Expenses still fronted by Daisy and Daisy would cut a check of net profits after number is finalized
    - WMS and WHS likely wouldn't have funds for use until EOY or early next year because that's when numbers would be finalized
- We need both donations and prizes! Plenty of ways to get involved
