RTI & Tiered Interventions

Encourage individualized instruction and increasing student achievement by implementing a more formal RTI (response to intervention) process throughout the district.

- Provide ongoing professional development to highlight best practices for individualized instruction
- Implement data collection tools & progress monitoring tools to monitor & measure growth and assist teachers in providing tiered interventions
- Formalize I&RS (intervention & referral services) process to ensure students receive rigorous instruction in the least restrictive environment

District Policies, Procedures & Finances

Review & revise district policies, procedures & finances to reflect current state mandates and best practices in an educational environment and to ensure the district remains compliant and fiscally responsible

- Perform a detailed analysis of district policies through Board Committees
- Review school/district plans to ensure all are compliant with required and necessary information
- Look for additional opportunities to increase revenue sources for the district
