- It became the basis for the First Amendment to the U.S.
   Constitution which protects religious freedom.

Why was the Virginia Declaration of Rights an important document?

- This document states that all Virginians should have the rights to free religion and press.
- It became the basis on which the Bill of Rights of the U.S.
   Constitution was written.
