AHS Admissions Process

- The AHS is best suited for students who voluntarily decide to apply to the program.
- Students can be referred by teachers, school counselors, psychologists and social workers.
- Student and parent must fill out an application which can be obtained in the main office, guidance office or at the AHS.
- Once application is received, an interview is set up between student, parent(s), and AHS staff.
- Interviews are typically during June (Regents week).

Admissions Continued

Admission into the AHS is based on the following criteria:

- Completion and quality of application
- Teacher, counselor, social worker, psychologist and administration recommendations.
- Interview
- The ability to meet the student's academic needs

AHS Philosophy

- The AHS is designed to meet the needs of students who, for a variety of reasons, learn best by following a non-traditional path.
- Students can succeed when learning takes place in an open and diverse environment that challenges them in a non-threatening manner.
