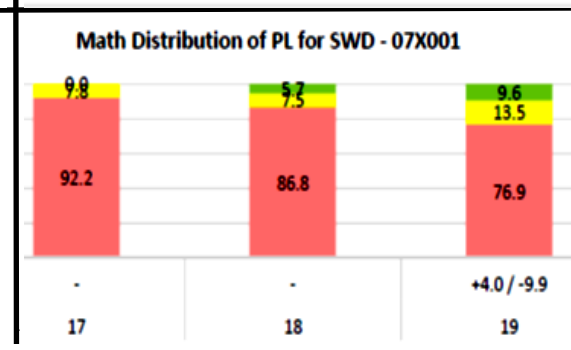
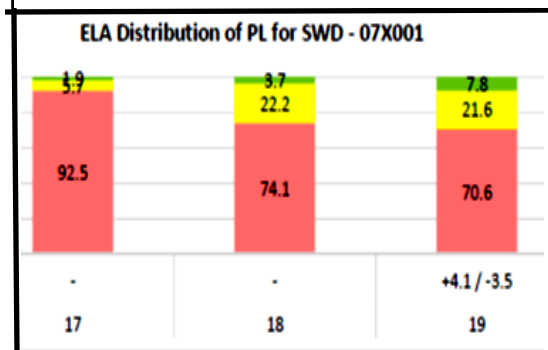
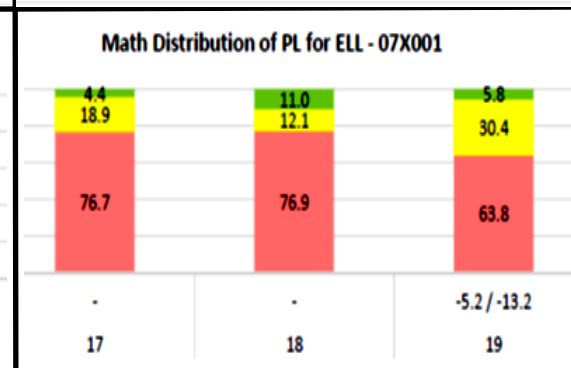
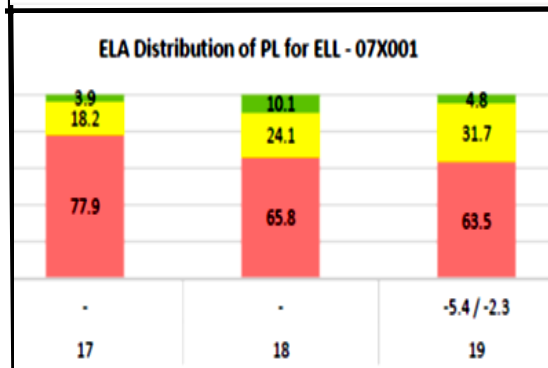
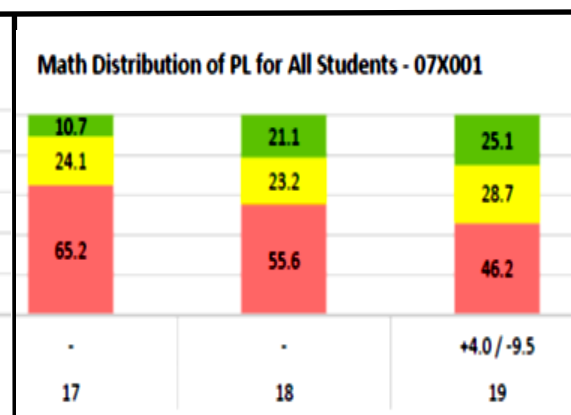
Instructional Focus
