## UNDERSTANDING A SCORE

- Percentile Rank (PR): A norm-referenced achievement score from 1-99 that provides a measure of a student's math ability compared to other students in the same grade nationally.

These slides show the percentile of student who were at or above benchmark during the fall and the spring 2022 assessments.

- Student Growth Percentile (SGP): A norm-referenced growth score from 1-99; it compares a student's growth between two assessment periods to that of his/her academic peers nationally.

These slides show the SGP between the fall and the spring 2022 math assessments.

# How can we understand Student Growth Percentile? (SGP) 

| Greater growth -66 th and above SGP |
| :---: |
| Typical growth -35 th -65 th SGP |
| Less than typical growth - below 34th SGP |
