Respectfully Submitted, Cathy Vogel Oglethorpe Charter School after the pandemic. Oglethorpe Charter School was no different than any other school. We saw behaviors that we had never seen before. As a new safety initiative this year, we have placed an Assistant Principal on every teaching team. They spend 90 percent of their day highly visible in the hallway. They also are in the cafeteria with their teaching team every day during lunch and structured free time. Their presence has greatly reduced many incidents.

Cookie Dough Dress-Down Days and Food Court: The dress-down days and food court trip for those students who sold cookie dough will take place after the Christmas break in January. This was a win-win fundraiser for all students and families. Parents will now receive all required family contract volunteer hours that sold just one tub of cookie dough. Students will receive 5 free dress-down days for selling 1-4 tubs of cookie dough. Students who sold 5-9 tubs of cookie dough will receive 10 free dressdown days. Students who sold 10 or more tubs of cookie dough will receive 10 free dress-down days and a trip to the Oglethorpe Food Court during their lunchtime.

Note: Please contact Sarita Grant if your family has a sibling who will be attending Oglethorpe next year. This process is called sibling preference. If you have a currently enrolled student at Oglethorpe Charter School and that student has a sibling in 5th grade or 6th or 7th grade at another middle school, you can use sibling preference and bypass the lottery meaning that the sibling is automatically granted enrollment for the 2024-2025 School Year. We must have this information related to sibling preference to know how many seats to offer at our lottery.


- a. Bovs and girls are screened separately in private area.
