GMCS Cell Phones and Electronic Device (ED) Usage Policy

The phones/devices must be TURNED OFF upon arrival to the campus to the last bell of the day.

<u>1st Offense:</u> Electronic device will be confiscated, parent may recover electronic device from school's administrative office at the end of the day.

2nd Offense: Parent/guardian will be notified that it is the student's second offense and may re- cover the electronic device from the school's administrative office at the end of the semester.

<u>3rd + Offense(s):</u> Charge of 12.22 Misbehavior, and parent/guardian may recover the electronic device from the schools administrative office at end of the school year.

The District shall not be liable or responsible for the loss of, or damage to, any electronic device confiscated from a student pursuant to this policy.

The use of a cell phone by anyone during a Lock Down is strictly prohibited for the safety of all students and staff.

The USE of a CELL PHONE during standardized testing could result in a charge of DDT (Dangerous and Disruptive Tactics), short-term suspension and attending a District Hearing.

Cell phones must be stored in lockers during mandated testing days.

We **will not** investigate any electronic devices that have been lost or stolen as per board policy.
