Administration #1

NOTE: All exams noted will take place in-person at the high school and will be <u>paper and pencil</u> <u>only at this time</u>. A student can elect to take MOST of these exams on-line, at home during Administration #3.

Due to logistical concerns including the ability to access available proctors, we will be able to accommodate any student who would prefer to take the digital exam in lieu of the paper exam (except World Languages and Music Theory). Per the College Board, the French, Spanish, Latin and Music Theory AP exams are not accessible in the digital format/at home during any administration. These exams must be taken on site, at the high school.

Administration #2
