Essential Components

- 1. Universal screenings of academics and behavior to determine which students need closer monitoring or additional interventions.
- 2. Differentiation of instruction and use of scientific, research-based instruction and interventions.
- 3. Multiple tiers of increasingly intense scientific, research-based interventions that are matched to student needs.
- 4. Monitoring student progress in response to the instruction, interventions, and supports.
- 5. Use of progress-monitoring data to shape instruction and make educational decisions.
- 6. Comprehensive stakeholder involvement throughout the process.
