

# Student Transportation Overview for Families

Published August 2019

Transportation services that are available to families vary by school, and by each child's eligibility for those services. Speak with your school if you have questions about the available options.

#### **Options**

- MetroCards are distributed by your school for use on MTA subways & non-express buses
- School Bus Transportation picks up and drops off students at designated bus stops
- Specialized Transportation is arranged to meet a student's particular needs

# Eligibility

- MetroCards → Live greater than one-half (1/2) mile from school
- School Bus Transportation → Depends on grade-based distance requirements
- Specialized Transportation → Possess an IEP listing transportation accommodations
- Students who are Temporarily Housed (including Homeless and Foster Care) → Free transportation, through the school year in which they become permanently housed

### **Prepare**

- Ensure all emergency contact information is kept up to date
- Update your school with any changes to residency or living arrangements
- Know your bus stop, and arrive 5-10 minutes before the scheduled pickup time

**REGISTER** 

Your school can help you sign up for a **NYC Schools Account**, which displays real-time bus information and service changes

**KEEP US UPDATED** 

Immediately notify your school and bus driver of any changes in your address or contact information

**MEET YOUR BUS TEAM** 

Get to know your bus driver and attendant, and make sure you have your bus company's phone number
