## #4 AP ART 2018 / 19 SUMMER ASSIGMENT PAPER BAG SKETCHBOOK MIGRATION



**MIGRATION**: movement of one part toward another; to change/exchange position or location.

YOU HAVE BEEN GIVEN A PAPER BAG(S) AND A SKETCHBOOK.
FIND A LARGE EMPTY CONTAINER THAT FITS COMPLETLY UNSEEN INSIDE THE BAG

- 1. Create an image of the bag open, empty and with nothing in it
- 2. Create an image of the bag with your container inside the bag.
- 3. Create an image of the bag crushes and smoothed around the container so the bag reveals the shape of what it contains.
- 4. Push the bag down and reveal the actual container. Create an image of this.
- 5. Take the container out of the bag and refolded and straighten out the bag, Create an image of them.
- 6. Create 3 more images of the paper bag slowly migrating completely into the container.
- 7. Create an image of your container empty and with nothing in it.

## NINE IMAGES TOTAL

- Each image should be as large as the sketchbook paper.
- Images should depict the subject as accurately and as detailed as your chosen media will allow.
- No media restriction.

All 9 images are due, in the sketchbook, on the first full day of classes.
