(6) Middle School Information for $4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ graders -A subcommittee will be formed to work on information package and plan; -PTA will make a call to all $4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ grade parents to recruit members; -Rohi, Jill and David from the SLT will participate on the subcommittee.
(7) Action plan for sustainability initiative
-The school has started a weekly recycling song over speaker;
-They will announce the highest grades and most improvement on recycling efforts in the classrooms;
-The classes (and lunchroom) have been notified that their recycling will be assessed (graded);
-Green Dreamers are doing a survey with local establishments to find out how "green" they are in order to recommend how they can be more sustainable (the broader student community will replicate survey with their chosen establishment and publicize the results);
-Additional activities planned:
-Set up screening of "Microplastic Madness"
-Have filmmaker of "Broken" come in and talk to $4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ graders -Ms. Cyphers is pulling together a list for recycling/garbage bins that are needed in school;
-Ask each class come up with their own "best practices";
-Organize an event to support homeless animals due to wildfires.
