- Results of teacher survey were discussed
 - Most teachers indicated interest in starting seeds in their classrooms. Nicole will get them materials to start seeds by next week.
 - Seeds will be given to Michele for seed packet project
 - Teachers indicated interest in helping out more with the garden
 - Discussed creating a list of tasks to be done in the garden
 - Decided that each class will be responsible for planting one of the early cold weather crops.
 - Need to determine if teachers want help/ support in doing this and what sort of schedule would work best for them. Mary will reach out to elementary teachers about this
 - We will need to mark off areas for each to be planted
 - Nicole reached out to Meg Smith regarding some ideas she has about curriculum integration
- Early Spring to do list for front garden was discussed
 - Some sand will need to be removed from beds
 - Once goat manure is obtained it will need to be added to beds.
 - Once goat manure is added, early seeds can be planted
